Spiritual Effects of Cryptid Encounters: An Analysis of Different Types of Encounters

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The purpose of my research was to use information from my current data set to determine the spiritual effects of cryptid encounters. The data set is composed of the following types of encounters: one-shot, circumstantial encounters, non-agreed habitual encounters, and encounters of those who seek cryptids as field researchers. These data sets have been evaluated by AI technology to extract the following results. For the purpose of this data set, the term "cryptid" specifically refers to the following: Bigfoot (sasquatch), Dogman, and Skinwalkers (although not generally classified as a cryptid).

Definition of Types of Encounters:

One-shot chance encounters are defined as wrong place, wrong time encounters, where the eyewitness happens upon the wrong location and encounters a cryptid. This person is unaware of the existence of these entities and is, for all purposes, an anomie.

Non-agreed habitual encounters are defined for the purpose of this data set as a group or groups of individuals who have recurring encounters on property that they own or lease, be it commercial or residential. These people typically have no knowledge of these entities in the beginning and are slowly brought into the understanding that they exist. Often, they are presented with a choice of acceptance or rejection via actions taken.

Implied agreement encounters are defined as people who have knowledge of cryptids and actively seek or research them either online or in the field.

Methods: Conversational data extraction refers to the process of automatically extracting relevant data or information from a conversation between two or more individuals. This involves using natural language processing (NLP) techniques to analyze the conversation and identify key pieces of information, such as names, dates, locations, and other relevant details.

Conversational data extraction can be used in a variety of settings, such as customer service interactions, interviews, or focus groups. For example, a company might use conversational data extraction to analyze customer feedback from a call center to identify common issues and improve their products or services. Another example is a research team using conversational data extraction to analyze interview data from participants to identify trends or insights. This can help researchers gain a better understanding of the perspectives and experiences of the people they are studying.

The following conclusions have been derived from a data set of 150 conversations. The purpose of this small data set is to identify common themes or trends in conversations and provide valuable insights. Larger data sets are available; however, the time to organize and arrange data for AI analysis is not feasible.

Results:

One-shot encounters:

Only 22% of individuals who experienced a brief encounter with a cryptid experienced any of the following negative side effects: Hitchhiker Effect, Poltergeist activity, martial and relationship issues, or inclination towards perversions.

Non-agreed habitual encounters:

28% of eyewitnesses experienced Poltergeist activity inside their home or place of business. This activity is broken down into several types of manifestations, the most prevalent being the presence of shadows (non-attributed to floaters in eyes), feeling of being watched, intense feeling of presence behind them, or directly attached to them. Physical side effects included headaches, pain behind left eyeball, stomach illness (undiagnosed). As a result of the Poltergeist or supernatural influences, there is a noted increase in alcohol consumption and tobacco usage. Emotional side effects included specific patterns of anger, fear, paranoia, and increased irrational behavior (these emotional side effects are what lead to damage in relationships and marriages).

Implied agreement encounters:

52% of eyewitnesses and researchers experienced Poltergeist activity inside the home or place of business, regardless of distance from the research area. The most prevalent being sleep paralysis 3-7 times per week, regardless of circadian rhythm. Full manifestation of shadowmen in the place of residence or work. Physical side effects include lack of sleep, headaches, eye pain, brain fog, dizziness, constipation, erectile dysfunction, stomach problems including IBS, acid reflux. As a result of the Poltergeist or supernatural influences, there is a noted increase in alcohol consumption and tobacco usage. In extreme cases, drug usage can lead to addiction. There is also an increase in sexual activity that would be considered perverted by 1980 standards, such as swinging and extreme porn addictions. Along with sleep deprivation, headaches, and brain fog, there is a noticeable change in the physical appearance of these individuals. Emotional side effects include extreme outbursts of anger, severe paranoia, and irrational decisions. The combination of these factors leads to the isolation of the subject. Many of these individuals have seen divorces, breakups, and in extreme cases, suicidal thoughts and emotions.

Overall, the research conducted using conversational data extraction techniques indicates that encounters with cryptids can have spiritual effects on individuals, particularly in the case of non-agreed habitual and implied agreement encounters. These effects include poltergeist activity, physical symptoms, emotional side effects, and increased substance abuse and sexual activity. These findings highlight the need for further research on this topic to gain a better understanding of the potential impact of cryptid encounters on individuals' spiritual well-being.
